KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Translates documents from English to one or more of the second languages listed above; provides in-person and over the phone interpretation. Has sharable knowledge regarding ethno-cultural groups and can provide insight into norms, traditions, and phrases relating to groups.
- Aids in the writing of client stories, translating client stories into first language, builds rapport with clients and monitors comfort level of participants.
- Works closely with direct supervisor Impact Producer to support in project goals.
- Adheres to the policies and standards of Options Community Services Society (OCS), as established in policy and program manuals, Health & Safety Guidelines, job descriptions, written memos, and verbal agreements.
- Works closely with contractor InWithForward in order to meet project outputs and outcomes and to administer project deliverables efficiently and effectively.
- Works collaboratively with Immigrant Services program managers and staff, especially in activities that relate to project deliverables.
- Ensures that accurate project and client records are maintained, that confidentiality is a priority, and that all pertinent requirements and documentation is complete.
- Ensures that the project meets or exceeds contract objectives.
- Performs other related duties as required.
