 - o providing community resources to clients
 - o proving meals as needed
 - o accepting clients into the shelter throughout the night
 - o doing wellness checks
 - o assisting site volunteers
 - o maintain positive relationships with the community
- Communicate with Extreme Weather Shelter volunteers at the beginning and end of shifts any necessary information
- Perform other duties necessary for the enhancement of the program as directed by senior manager or designate

- Current Level I First Aid certificate required
- Non-Violent Crisis Intervention training required
- Naloxone training required (training can be provided)
- Crisis Line training an asset
