This position is responsible for providing one to one service to children aged 3-18 years who have autism and /or development disabilities.

#### **KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Working with children ages 3-18 who have a developmental disability.
- May also work with Adults who have a developmental disability.
- Responsibility for creating and implementing strategies designed to work toward individual client goals such as the development of social and life skills, communication skills, behavior management skills and community involvement.
- Responsibility for scheduling, report writing and budgeting.
- Must be able to work in a team setting.
- Lifting/bending may be required.
- Performs other information and referral duties as directed by the Program Manager, or designate.

- Bachelor's Degree and/ or combination of relevant education and experience.

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- Current Level I First Aid Certificate.
