ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Assist in finding homeless people who need support services and who otherwise would not seek assistance.
- Engage with homeless people and provide support in order to stabilize their lives.
- Connect people with income support. This may include making and accompanying people to appointments.
- Assist people in locating a rental unit and ensuring that an Intent to Rent form and/or a social housing application have been completed.
- Provide follow-up support to ensure people have effectively transitioned to housing and related health and social service programs and services.
- Provide links to learning and follow up related to the areas of life skills, personal health, hygiene, household management, financial management, crisis intervention, problem solving.
- Perform other duties necessary for the enhancement of the program as directed by assistant program manager or program manager.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Working towards a degree/diploma in social services or a related field.
- Previous experience volunteering in a non-profit organization.
- First-Aid certificate.
- Valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS
