This position will assist the Transition House Workers (THW) in providing information, referrals and advocacy to women residents and callers on the Support Line. They will also assist the Child and Youth Support Worker (CYSW) with providing direct support to resident children, coordinating and implementing children's programs, providing parenting support to the resident moms, and providing appropriate in-house responsibilities.

ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Coordinating and implementing children's recreational activities such as craft projects, and indoor and outdoor games and garden activities.
- Preparing and setting up equipment or materials for activities and playing.
- Assisting with meeting physical needs of residents (linens, food, clothing, personal toiletries)
- Assist with crisis intervention through our support lines.
- Assist in the overall functioning of the program by completing tasks assigned by staff / supervisor.
- Respectful communication with all residents is expected. Client service skills, active listening and clear communication are promoted. A Student will be mentored and monitored on daily basis, and will have opportunity to shadow staff directly, until comfort level and skill necessary to communicate with children and women in crisis is obtained.
- Assists in maintaining program records, documentation and administrative duties as assigned
- Liaise with other agencies/professionals related to women and their goals and help to expand resource files through research.
- Participates in day to day program tasks as needed and with direct supervision.
- Performs other duties, as required.
