- Oversee the recruitment, hiring, training, and supervision of staff members at each of the clubhouses.
- Ensure that the clubhouses are providing high-quality services and meeting the needs of their members.
- Develop and implement program goals, objectives, and outcomes, and regularly evaluate program effectiveness.
- Monitor program budgets and expenditures to ensure that financial resources are being used effectively.
- Foster and maintain positive relationships with community partners, stakeholders, and funders.
- Ensure that all required reports and documentation are completed accurately and in a timely manner.
- Develop and maintain systems to ensure that the clubhouses are meeting all required licensing, accreditation, and regulatory requirements.
- Maintain and update policies and procedures to ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
- Makes recommendations with regard to the development of the program and participates in program evaluations. Assesses strategy on an ongoing basis to ensure effectiveness of service.
- Provide leadership and guidance to staff members, including ongoing training and professional development opportunities.
- Collaborate with other program managers and agency leadership to ensure that the clubhouses are integrated into the overall mission and vision of Options Community Services.
- Perform other duties as needed.

### Education, Training, and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in a related field (e.g., social work, psychology, counseling, public health, or a related field)
- Minimum of five years of experience in program management, preferably in a human services or communitybased organization.
- Class 5 driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle is required.
