The Resident Support Worker (RSW) is responsible for working with second stage housing resident women and children who are at risk of, or have experienced violence/abuse. This position involves providing access to related safe and confidential services, including support services focused on emotional support, information, and referrals to community and government agencies.

ACCOUNTABILITIES

Resident Relations and Support:

- Participate in the selection, move in process, orientation, and departure/move out process of residents to the program.
- Collaboratively identify, assess, and create an on-going needs assessment of women and their children and assist them to define and implement an action plan based on their identified needs and goals.
- Assist with referrals, advocacy and planning for seeking permanent housing.
- Provide crisis intervention, information and assistance to help residents meet their obligations and to facilitate access or follow through with available site and community resources.
- Mediate disputes among residents, with a view to helping residents learn to problem-solve such disputes more independently.
- Assist the residents in developing and using individualized wellness plans which may involve: financial related concerns/budgeting, mediating social conflict, assisting individuals with problem solving, encouraging unit cleanliness and personal hygiene practices.
- Performs other duties, as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education, Training, and Experience:

• Diploma in a social service or a related field and a minimum of one (1) year recent related experience. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.

- First Aid Certificate with CPR C and AED is required.
- Class 5 Driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle is required.

• Understanding of cycle of abuse, the dynamics of violence against women in relationships and the intergenerational cycle of abuse, as well as, fluent with all relevant policies, procedures and legislation.

- Demonstrated proficiency in written, oral and interpersonal communication skills
- Ability to organize work, set priorities and take initiative in meeting deadlines and carrying out the duties of the position

- Demonstrated skills in crisis intervention, mediation and conflict resolution;
- Demonstrated ability to build and maintain professional, confidential relationships with multi-barriered people;
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills;

- Demonstrated ability to work with a diverse client base and with people who may have experienced abuse, poverty, grief and loss, oppression, violence, mental health challenges, and/or addiction issues, and/or those who may be living with HIV/AIDS or other life-limiting of life-threatening conditions.
